Their journey was not an easy one, as they faced numerous hardships while living in hotels and emergency shelters. But in the darkest moments of their struggle, a glimmer of hope emerged through the support of Home of the Sparrow's Transitional Shelter. This shelter became their lifeline, providing not only a roof over their heads but also a caring and compassionate community that embraced them. The staff at Home of the Sparrow recognized the immense love and sacrifice Mary had made for her grandchildren. They immediately enrolled her in their Rapid Rehousing Program, which provided the necessary resources, guidance, and a stepping stone toward a brighter future. Mary's story didn't stop at securing a roof over their heads. The organization also recognized the importance of addressing the mental health needs of her grandchildren, who had been deeply affected by their tumultuous journey. They provided access to the necessary mental health services, which allowed the children to heal and thrive.



As time passed, something beautiful started to happen. With their lives slowly stabilizing, the children's parents, who had faced their own struggles, were drawn back into their lives. The family began to rebuild, rekindling relationships and finding a way forward together. Mary's perseverance and the unwavering support of Home of the Sparrow had turned the tide for this remarkable family. Today, Mary and her five grandchildren are thriving in their safe, stable, and loving home. They have overcome incredible odds and are proof that even in the face of adversity, with the support of a caring community, the power of family, and the spirit of a grandmother's love, there is always a path to success.



HOS THRIFT STORES

Home of the Sparrow operates seven total thrift stores across Northern Illinois: six under the banner of Sparrow's Nest Thrift Store and Donation Centers, and one under Community Threads Upscale Resale Store. The purpose of our thrift stores is to support the mission of Home of the Sparrow and proceeds fund our programs and services.

Home of the Sparrow's Thrift Stores are also a zero cost provider of clothing, furniture and housewares to Home of the Sparrow clients and clients of other partnering agencies in Northern Illinois. With an exception to mattresses and box springs, everything sold in the thrift stores are new and/or gently used donations from members of the community.
