

## **DID YOU KNOW...**

## Home of the Sparrow has Rapid Rehousing Programs?

Home of the Sparrow provides several community-based **Rapid Rehousing** programs. HOS identifies individuals and families who may have fewer needs or more resources available but are still homeless, allowing for rapid placement into community-based housing. Clients in these programs still receive case management services while moving more quickly into permanent housing.

Upon program acceptance, HOS clients receive assistance finding rental housing and short-term financial aid for expenses like security deposits and the first month's rent. Comprehensive case management services cover various needs, including accessing community resources, budgeting, parenting, health, employment, and education.
