

MAXIMIZE YOUR IMPACT WITH A DONOR-ADVISED FUND

At Home of the Sparrow, we deeply appreciate the generosity of our donors, whose support helps us provide shelter, resources, and hope to women and children experiencing homelessness. If you're looking for a strategic and tax-efficient way to support our mission, a Donor-Advised Fund (DAF) may be a great option.

WHAT IS A DONOR-ADVISED FUND?

A Donor-Advised Fund is a charitable giving vehicle that allows donors to contribute cash, stocks, or other assets to a dedicated account, receive an immediate tax deduction, and then recommend grants over time to their favorite nonprofits, like Home of the Sparrow.

BENEFITS TO THE DONOR

- Immediate Tax Advantages You receive an immediate tax deduction for contributions made to your DAF, helping you manage your taxable income efficiently.
- **Flexible Giving** You can contribute to your DAF at any time and decide later when and how much to distribute to charities.
- **Investment Growth** Funds in a DAF can be invested and potentially grow tax-free, allowing for greater charitable impact over time.
- **Simplified Record-Keeping** A DAF consolidates your giving into a single account, making it easier to track your donations for tax and financial planning purposes.
- **Family Philanthropy** Many donors use DAFs to involve their children and grandchildren in charitable giving, fostering a legacy of philanthropy.

Just log into your DAF account, search for our organization, and designate your gift. You can also set up recurring contributions to make a lasting difference.

HOS THRIFT STORES

Home of the Sparrow operates seven total thrift stores across Northern Illinois; six under the banner of Sparrow's Nest Thrift Store and Donation Centers, and one under Community Threads Upscale Resale Store. The purpose of our thrift stores is to support the mission of Home of the Sparrow and proceeds fund our programs and services.

Home of the Sparrow's Thrift Stores are also a zero cost provider of clothing, furniture and housewares to Home of the Sparrow clients and clients of other partnering agencies in Northern Illinois. With an exception to mattresses and box springs, everything sold in the thrift stores are new and/or gently used donations from members of the community.
