HOPE FOR THE HOLIDAYS: HOW YOUR GENEROSITY HELPED SPENCER FIND STABILITY

If you received a holiday card from us this year, then you already know who Spencer is. But if you did not, please allow us to introduce you to Spencer and share the story of how your generosity helped transform his life. As we enter this season of gratitude and giving, we want to highlight the impact your support has on children and families right here in our community.

Spencer, a bright and resilient eight-year-old boy, is one of many whose lives have been forever changed because of donors like you.

Earlier this year, Spencer, his younger brother, and their mom found themselves **without a home** after a series of unexpected expenses pushed them beyond what they could manage. Their mom worked full time, but rising costs and an unexpected car repair left the family with no safety net. They spent weeks **living out of their car**, trying to keep routines intact and spirits high, even as uncertainty grew.



Everything changed the day they arrived at **Home of the Sparrow**.

Because of the generosity of our supporters, Spencer's family was welcomed into our **Transitional Shelter program**. Donor funding made it possible for them to receive **safe shelter, warm meals, case management**, and the **stability** they had been longing for.

From the moment they arrived, progress began. Spencer and his brother finally had **beds of their own**, a place to study, and a dependable routine. Their mom received one-on-one support to strengthen her finances, enroll in job training, and start planning for permanent housing. Each milestone was fueled by the resources made possible through donor contributions.

Now, in the heart of the holiday season, Spencer's family is filled with **hope**. They recently secured an affordable apartment and are preparing to celebrate the holidays in a home of their own. Spencer's mom says she finally feels like she can breathe again. The boys have already decorated their shared room, proudly showing off the space they never thought they would have.

This transformation did not happen by chance. ***It happened because of you.***

Your donations keep our shelter warm, our housing programs running, and our support services available for families who are working hard to rebuild their lives. **You helped turn a frightening and uncertain time into a season of hope for Spencer and his family.**

As we celebrate the holidays at Home of the Sparrow, we are reminded that every gift, large or small, helps create moments like these. Moments where families find stability, children rediscover joy, and hope is restored.

HOS THRIFT STORES

Home of the Sparrow operates seven total thrift stores across Northern Illinois; six under the banner of Sparrow's Nest Thrift Store and Donation Centers, and one under Community Threads Upscale Resale Store. The purpose of our thrift stores is to support the mission of Home of the Sparrow and proceeds fund our programs and services.

Home of the Sparrow's Thrift Stores are also a zero cost provider of clothing, furniture and housewares to Home of the Sparrow clients and clients of other partnering agencies in Northern Illinois. With an exception to mattresses and box springs, everything sold in the thrift stores are new and/or gently used donations from members of the community.
